

MAJOR SCHOLARSHIPS WITH UPCOMING APPLICATION DEADLINES

Horatio Alger Scholarship - students who have overcome adversity, family income maximum of \$55,000; students should maintain at least 2.0 GPA, participate in community service, complete application by 10/25. <https://scholars.horatioalger.org/>

Coca Cola Scholars Program - \$20,000 scholarship for students who have demonstrated their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. complete application by 10/31. <https://www.coca-colascholarsfoundation.org/apply/>

Indiana University Groups Scholars Program - the Groups Scholars Program provides academic, financial, and social support to selected underrepresented Indiana college students from matriculation to graduation and beyond. Ron Brown Scholar Program - RBSP competitively awards Ron Brown Scholars four-year \$40,000 scholarships (\$10,000 each year) to the most talented and economically-challenged high school seniors who demonstrate a keen interest in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship and global citizenship; early deadline 11/1; regular deadline 1/9 <https://www.ronbrown.org/section/apply/program-description>

Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student - \$1000- \$12,500 per year; finalists must attend Leadership weekend in Chicago. Awarded to students demonstrating leadership, academic achievement, community involvement, financial need. Apply by 11/15 <https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/mvs.cfm>

Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Scholarship - For high achieving students with demonstrated financial need - up to \$40,000/year; minimum unweighted cumulative GPA 3.5 or above; SAT minimum 1200 or ACT composite 26; Family income up to \$95,000 (last year's recipients had median family income of \$26,000); Apply by 11/20, add Jack Kent Cooke Foundation to Common App: <https://www.jkcf.org/our-scholarships/college-scholarship-program/>

AXA Achievement Scholarship - Awards in the amount of \$2,500, \$10,000, or \$25,000. Primary consideration will be given to the applicant's non-academic outstanding achievement as described in the online application essays when selecting finalists. The achievement may be a long-term achievement, an activity or a project that occurred in their school, in the community or in the workplace. Other extracurricular activities in school and community, work experience, and the applicant's academic record over the past four years will be considered when selecting finalists. 1st 10,000 applications accepted, open Sept. 1- Dec. 14, 2018; <https://www.scholarsapply.org/axa-achievement/>

GE Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program - \$10,000/year (renewable); 3.0 GPA minimum, applicant must demonstrate leadership, citizenship, integrity, drive. Demonstrated financial need considered.
