Grading Scale

Brebeuf Jesuit uses a 4.0 grading scale, which is outlined on the transcript. Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted an extra 1.0 point and Honors courses are weighted an extra 0.5 point. The school-wide grading scale is as follows:

Advanced Placement

In 2018-2019, 386 students took a total of 786 AP Exams.

Graduation Requirements

All students are required to take a minimum of six courses per semester. Freshmen are required to take seven per semester. A total of 50 credit hours plus an additional 40 hours of external community service are required for graduation. Required credit hours include:
