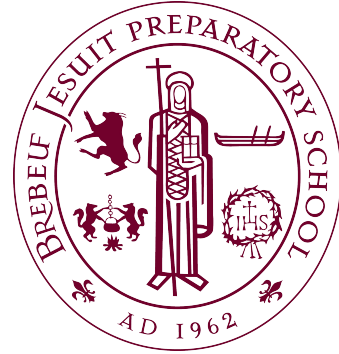


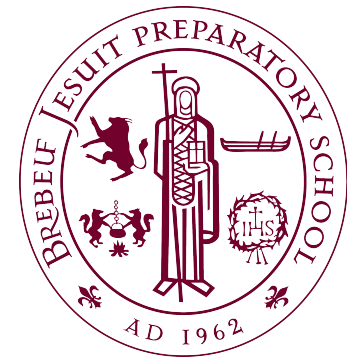

Academic Counseling:

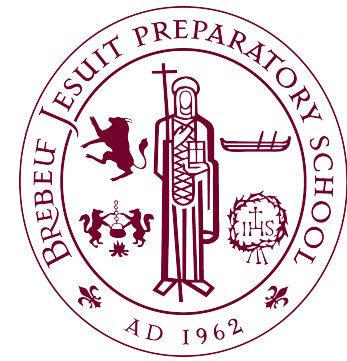


The mission of the Academic Counseling Office is to develop a relationship with each student, beginning their freshman year.

Freshman Seminar is assigned to all freshmen for the fall semester of freshman year and taught by the student's academic counselor.

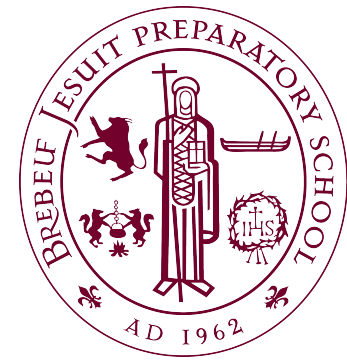

Coffee with the Counselors

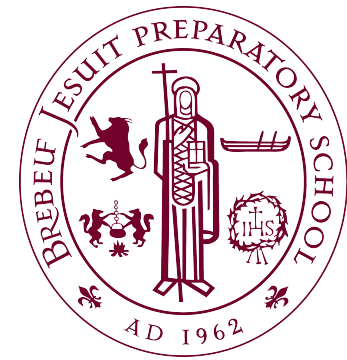
Coffee with the Counselors is a series of informative morning meetings with the academic counselors to help you navigate important topics relevant to your student during their time here at Brebeuf.
