Grading Scale

Brebeuf Jesuit uses a 4.0 grading scale, which is outlined on the transcript. Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted an extra 1.0 point and Honors courses are weighted an extra 0.5 point. The school-wide grading scale is as follows:

Advanced Placement

In 2019-2020, 393 students took a total of 800 AP Exams.

- 30 AP Scholars with Honors
